#### **New Report: Making Care Pay Work**

As members on the front lines of the coronavirus pandemic know better than most, direct care workers are critically important to our nation's health—but they are not usually valued accordingly. A new LeadingAge study, Making Care Pay Work, offers a glimpse into a different world in which direct care workers earn at least a living wage. The research demonstrates that the single action of paying direct care workers a living wage has the power to reduce staff shortages and turn-over, improve productivity and quality of care, infuse billions of dollars into local economies, and offer financial security and independence of care workers themselves.
