RE:	ARPA Funding Availability Update

On behalf of Governor DeWine and the Ohio Department of Aging, I am pleased to formally announce that Residential Care Facilities (RCFs) are eligible for grant funding pursuant to Ohio House Bill 169. As a RCF with Assisted Living beds licensed by the Ohio Department of Health, you may be eligible to receive relief equal to \$500 per licensed bed.

As part of the application process, you will need a unique five-digit invitation ID, found on the homepage of the <u>ODA COVID-19 Care Center</u>. You must also be registered as a State of Ohio Supplier. According to a search of our records, it appears you do not yet have a Supplier ID.

Please follow the steps below to begin the Supplier registration process:

1. Create an account in OHIID at <u>ohid.ohio.gov</u>. The username/password that you use when creating your OHIID will be used to access the Ohio Supplier Portal.

2. Using your OHID username/password, access the Ohio Supplier Portal at <u>supplier.ohio.gov</u> to register as a Supplier and receive your Supplier ID.

Note 1: Upon completion you will receive a registration ID number, which is not your Supplier ID and is used for internal tracking purposes only. It will be used in the next step to register as a State of Ohio Supplier.

Note 2: As part of this process, you will be required to attach a properly completed Internal Revenue Service Form W9. As of January 1, 2017, all state of Ohio Suppliers are required to provide electronic funds transfer (EFT) information and to receive payment via direct deposit. You will enter your banking information during the registration process so please have it readily available.

Note 3: After submitting your online Supplier registration your information will be reviewed and verified for completeness. This process can take up to 10-15 business days. Once approved you will receive an email from <u>noreply.oaks@oaks.state.oh.us</u> with your new Supplier ID.

3. When you have received your Supplier ID, go to <u>grants.ohio.gov/fundingopportunities.aspx</u> to begin the grant application process.

Locate the hyperlink for the funding opportunity Relief for Assisted Living Providers. A form will pop-up to be completed (ensure your pop-up blocker is disabled in your settings). Once complete, please scroll down to the bottom and click the register button.
