<input type="checkbox"/> April 12, 2023	Unnecessary Medications <i>CMS is targeting unnecessary medications and inappropriate Schizophrenia diagnoses in nursing homes as outlined in the QSO-23-05-NH memo. Unnecessary psychotropic medications F-tag 758 is one of the ten most frequently cited deficiencies during the annual survey for Ohio in 2022. This session will cover the most recent information about the Schizophrenia audits. The surveyor protocol in determining what constitutes unnecessary medications will be covered including citation examples related to gradual dose reductions. ODH updates and current citation trends in Ohio will be discussed.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> May 10, 2023	Behavioral Health Services <i>CMS added a significant amount of language and surveyor guidance to the State Operations Manual Appendix PP in October of 2022 with phase 3 of the requirements of participation. This session will cover the surveyor guidance for behavioral health services, including the prevention and treatment of mental and substance use disorders guidance. ODH updates and current citation trends in Ohio will be discussed.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> June 14, 2023	Emergency Preparedness <i>Ohio has recently experienced significant disaster events requiring numerous communities to evacuate their community including nursing homes, residential care facilities, and additional provider types. Effective emergency preparedness plans were noted as the reason for successful evacuations by the Ohio Department of Health. This session will cover best practices identified through recent events. Regulatory requirements and resources will be reviewed. ODH updates and current citation trends in Ohio will be discussed.</i>
